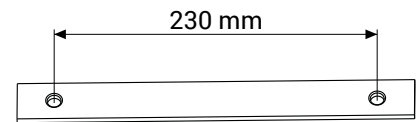
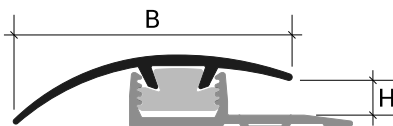


Patented profile designed to accommodate flooring height differences of 0" to 1/4" (0 to 6 mm).

The plastic modular insert makes MULTICLIP a durable and highly wear resistant transition system that also allows for movement. The versatility of the visible cap easily and seamlessly adapts to slight height differences between flooring materials.

MATERIAL DESCRIPTION

Aluminum

The primary aluminum alloy EN AW-6060 in T6 temper is suitable for complex extrusions, offering high strength and an excellent natural surface finish that lends itself well to subsequent finishing processes.

ANODIZED ALUMINUM:

The anodic oxidation process provides protection against corrosion caused by atmospheric agents, without involving galvanic treatments.

According to the EN 12373 standard, the profiles are treated with preventive processes that make them uniformly opaque, subsequently they are coloured through an electro-chemical oxidation process in the standard colours Silver, Gold, Bronze, Copper and Titanium with a thickness of up to 10 microns.

SUBLIMATED ALUMINUM:

The finish obtained through the painting and sublimation process is a process that consists of a first phase corresponding to the powder coating process and a second phase that uses sublimation transfer technology. This allows images or decorations to be transferred from a film to an object, usually metal, using heat and pressure, creating a high-quality and durable aesthetic finish.

In addition to presenting realistic decorative effects, it also retains the characteristics of an electrostatic painting based on polyester powders.

APPLICATION

1. Choose the MULTICLIP profile (finishing), the CLB profile (base) and the CL profile (adjustment clip).
2. Cut the profiles to the desired length;
3. Spread the adhesive in the application area of the base or fix it with screws;
4. Lay the floors by resting them on the sides of the base, leaving the space that will house the CL profile (clip) free;
5. Insert the CL profile into the appropriate dovetail slot of the MULTICLIP finishing profile;
6. Finally, fit the newly coupled profiles (MULTICLIP + CL) into the base (CLB) by applying progressively greater pressure, for example by placing a wooden board on the profile and hitting it lightly with a rubber hammer.

N.B.: Aluminum profiles offer limited resistance to alkaline substances, so their use must be evaluated according to the expected chemical aggressions. Aluminum profiles in contact with cementitious substances can be attacked by corrosion processes, so residues of adhesives and sealants used must be removed immediately. When laying, the right amount of adhesive must be used and the right drying times observed, avoiding creating cavities in which water can stagnate, which would lead to the formation of alkaline substances (aluminum hydroxide) and trigger corrosive electrolytic phenomena.

(The perforated version of the base has a center distance of 9" - 230 mm between successive holes)

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

ALUMINIUM:

Aluminum requires no special maintenance.

For cleaning, use colorless alcohol diluted in water or neutral detergents, avoiding acidic ones (e.g., hydrochloric or hydrofluoric acid); use non-abrasive sponges or cloths to avoid damage. We recommend not applying cleaners directly to surfaces. After cleaning, rinse with water and dry immediately with a soft cloth. Avoid polishes. Quickly remove residual cement or grout to protect the surface.
